Each of our 3 classrooms are multi-grade and our average student enrollment is 25-30 with roughly 10 students per classroom. This is part of the charm of Guffey School, in addition to working in a beautiful mountain paradise.

GCCS is a public charter school authorized by the Park County RE-2 District in rural Park County serving students kindergarten through 8th grade and is located in the off-the-beaten-path town of Guffey, CO.
